Dear Parents and Carers,

This week, the Department for Education has launched its 'Moments Matter, Attendance Counts' campaign. This campaign is very important to us, and we completely agree with their message.

We know that sometimes our pupils cannot come to school because they are really unwell - and that's the right thing to do for them and other pupils. Medical advice is clear however that children with mild illness will often be well enough to attend - for example if they have a cough, or cold, without a temperature. The NHS guidance 'Is my child too ill for school?' (Link in the comments below) is designed to support parents in their decision making about mild illness.

We are building life skills, life-long friendships and preparing your child for future success, and we can only do this if your child is in school. We will work with families, and going forward if your child's attendance is below 95%, we will be reaching out to you to offer support and make sure we are all doing everything we can.
