Dear Parents and Carers,

As some of you may know, we use a scheme called Jigsaw to teach PSHE (Personal, Social and Health Education) across the school.

The lessons build children’s emotional literacy, self-esteem and knowledge of who they are and how they relate to each other. Each half-term has a different Jigsaw puzzle piece and this half-term is ‘Dreams and Goals’. Teachers are spending time each week talking to the children about their ambition in the short and long term and how they can achieve that.

Next half-term we focus on ‘Healthy Me’ and then in the summer term ‘Relationships’ and ‘Changing Me’. As part of this, we would like to invite parents to a Teams meeting to consult on our Relationship and Sex Education Policy, this will be next Tuesday at 4pm on Teams. We would like to engage with parents on this and we will also discuss with governors.
